Why order through SEWP VI

SEWP VI is NASA's Government-Wide Acquisition Contract for IT, open to all federal agencies (including DoD) and their authorized support contractors. The ordering period runs November 1, 2026 through October 31, 2036. The handling fee is 0.34% — among the lowest of any GWAC — and it is already built into every quoted price. Products not yet on contract are added through Technology Refresh, often within one business day.

Task orders support firm fixed price, time-and-material, labor-hour, and hybrid contract types. Category A covers commercial IT products — hardware, software, cloud — plus the installation, integration, maintenance, and training that make them work.

Firm fixed price against 80TECH26D2112. New items added via Technology Refresh in 1–2 business days.
- 4

Evaluate and select
Compare quotes in the QRT. The 0.34% fee is already inside every quoted price.
- 5

Issue the order
Through your agency's procurement system, citing the contract and Tailwind quote number.
- 6

Route through SEWP
Send the signed order to the SEWP Program Office (copy SEWP6@tailwindrg.com). SEWP verifies and forwards — usually same day.
- 7

Delivery and support
We confirm, ship or schedule services, and invoice per order terms.

PAYMENT & CREDIT CARDS

Tailwind accepts purchase orders and government purchase cards. All orders route through the SEWP Program Office so they are recorded against the contract.

Quotes through SEWP tools

Use the Quote Request Tool (QRT) at sewp.nasa.gov: select Category A, include the Small Business / WOSB group or name Tailwind Resource Group directly, attach specs, and set your close time — same-day close is supported for urgent requirements. QRT requests satisfy fair-opportunity automatically. For a market-research estimate first, email SEWP6@tailwindrg.com. We respond directly — no marketing list.

Warranty policy

Tailwind Resource Group provides manufacturer-authorized products and software. Warranty coverage is provided in accordance with the manufacturer's standard warranty unless otherwise specified on the quotation or purchase order. Optional extended warranties, premium support, and maintenance agreements are available for many products and should be requested at the time of quotation.

Order issue resolution

Tailwind Resource Group is committed to resolving order-related issues promptly and professionally. Customers should report any order discrepancies as soon as they are identified. Tailwind will coordinate directly with the customer, distributor, manufacturer, and shipping carrier, as applicable, to resolve the issue.

Fair opportunity

[FAR 16.505\(b\)\(1\)](#) provides that each contractor shall be given fair opportunity to be considered for each order exceeding \$10,000 and issued under multiple award contracts. The FAR states that the method to obtain fair opportunity is at the discretion of the Contracting Officer (CO) and the CO must document the rationale for placement and price of each order. Using the SEWP online Quote Request Tool is the recommended method to assist in this activity and to augment the required decision documentation. The SEWP Quote Request Tool (QRT) will automatically include the Contract Holders within a selected Group or based on a suggested source.
